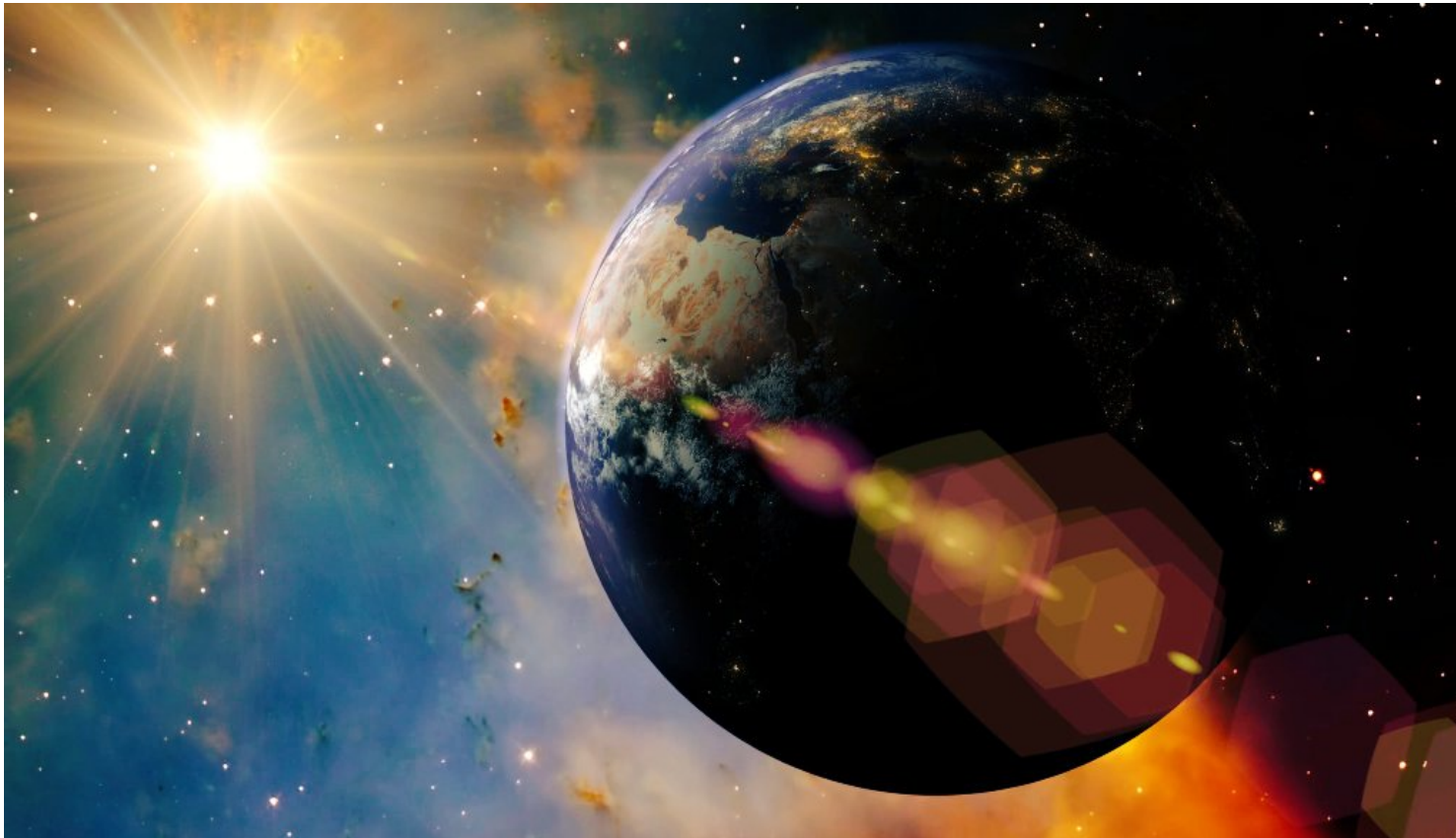

“And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were *passed away*; and there was no more *sea*” (Revelation 21:1).



“And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will *dwell with them*, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be *with them*, and be their God” (Revelation 21:3).

“Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet *appear* what we *shall be*: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see *him* as he is” (1 John 3:2).

Will there be sin, suffering, or death?

“And *God shall* wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more *death*, neither *sorrow*, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the *former things* are passed away” (Revelation 21:4).

“Know ye not that the *unrighteous* shall *not inherit* the *kingdom of God*? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the

Can Christians be assurance of eternal life now?

"These things have I written unto you that *believe* on the name of the *Son of God*; that ye may *know* that ye have eternal life, and that ye may *believe* on the name of the *Son of God*" (1 John 5:13).

"Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to *give* you the *kingdom*" (Luke 12:32).

"Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the *holiest by the blood of Jesus*, By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; And having *an high priest over the house of God*; Let us *draw near* with a true heart *in full assurance of faith*, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the profession of *our faith without wavering*; (for *he is faithful* that promised" (Hebrews 10:19-23). See also 1 Peter 1:18-19.

Will anything future be able to separate us from the love of God?

"For I am *persuaded*, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth,

nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the *love of God*, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Romans 8:38-39).

“...for he hath said, I will never *leave thee*, nor *forsake thee*” (Hebrews 13:5).

“And if I go and *prepare a place* for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there *you* may be also” (John 14:3). See also Isaiah 25:9, Matthew 11:28, John 6:37, 1 Corinthians 1:9, & Revelation 22:17.

How can we be certain of a place in the Earth made new?

“And this is the record, that *God hath* given to us eternal life, and this life is in his *Son*. He that hath *the Son* hath *life*; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life” (1 John 5:11-12).

“Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing *he ever liveth* to make *intercession for them*” (Hebrews 7:25).
